



EPSB Disciplinary Procedure

Upon entering an EPSB event players agree to be bound by the current EPSB Standard Conditions of Entry, from the point of event entry until 7 days after the conclusion of that event.

In the event of any alleged breach of the Standard Conditions of Entry reported by the Tournament Director or any other party, the EPSB will have two options available as follows:

- 1) To issue a warning letter to the player as to the alleged breach.
- 2) To refer the matter to the EPSB Board who will then discuss.

Should the matter be referred to and discussed by the EPSB Board, the EPSB will then formally write to the player, who will have 14 days to respond. Following the receipt of a response, the EPSB will then have the following options available:

- No further action
- Warning letter
- Formal warning
- Suspended fine
- Fine

If, in the view of the EPSB the alleged breach is deemed so serious that it merits a greater sanction, the matter will be considered in full by the World Professional Billiards and Snooker Association (WPBSA) Disciplinary Committee.
