

EPSB Disciplinary Procedure

Upon entering an EPSB event players agree to be bound by the WPBSA Conduct Regulations from the point of event entry until 28 days after the conclusion of that event. The WPBSA Conduct Regulations can be found here.

The EPSB will follow the processes outlined in Part 2 of the WPBSA Conduct Regulations – The Disciplinary Rules.

The EPSB Board will nominate a person to carry out the functions of the Head of Integrity as outlined in the Disciplinary Rules. In the event where that person recommends that a Player is charged with a breach of the Conduct Regulations, the EPSB will appoint a disciplinary panel to hear the case. The disciplinary panel will be appointed by the Chair of the EPSB.

The power to suspend a Player under section 4 of Part 2 of the WPBSA Conduct Regulations will be exercised by the Chair of the EPSB.

At the discretion of the EPSB, any disciplinary case may be referred to the WPBSA Disciplinary Committee.

The EPSB reserves the right to levy appropriate costs on a Player who is found to be in breach of the Conduct Regulations.
