

Dress Code for 2021/2022 EPSB Tournaments

Players' dress code for all EPSB events* this season will consist a minimum of:

- Formal shoes (no trainers/sneakers etc.)
- Formal trousers (no jeans/cargos etc.)
- Smart and appropriate collared shirt or polo shirt (long or short sleeved)

However, all players who reach the final of any EPSB national championship ** at Finals Weekend (or elsewhere such as possibly the English Amateur Snooker Championship) will be required to wear:

- Formal shoes (no trainers/sneakers etc.)
- Formal trousers (no jeans/cargos etc.)
- Long sleeved collared shirt
- Waistcoat
- Bow tie or tie

^{*}The English Under-14 Championship has its own dress code criteria – please see separate correspondence for information on this.

^{*/**}The English Women's Snooker Championship dress code consists of long-sleeved shirt or blouse, waistcoat, trousers or skirt and shoes (bow tie / tie is optional) - this includes the final.

*/**The English Billiards Championship dress code consists of long-sleeved shirt, waistcoat, trousers and shoes. A bow tie / tie is optional for the opening day(s), but a bow tie / tie is required to be worn during the final day of the tournament in the main event.

EPSB Open Series

The dress code for all EPSB Open Series events will be relaxed from the above.

However, players must be dressed suitably for an organised competition with the tournament director to have the final decision on whether the attire is suitable.

(For example, no flipflops, scruffy jeans, sports shorts, dirty trainers, sleeveless tops, sponsored non-snooker sports tops - for example, football shirt etc.)

Should a player not meet the relevant dress code criteria in any of our events, they will not be permitted to play until they have the suitable attire on.
