Activity permitted within Covid-19 Local Restriction Tiers

The table below offers an overview of the Covid-19 Local Restriction Tiers with regard to permitted snooker and billiards activity. This information is indicative only and should be followed in line with current <u>UK Government guidance</u> and <u>EPSB guidance</u>.

Recreational play	Permitted – follow EPSB guidance	 Permitted Solo practice Adults playing together – singles only; can play one other household Groups – Disabled people, supervised activity for U18s, and activity for education purposes 	Not permitted in snooker clubs
1:1 Coaching	Permitted – follow EPSB guidance	Permitted – coach with one household/bubble only	Not permitted in snooker clubs Permitted in private facilities that are not open to the public
Competition (club tournaments, local league)	Permitted – follow EPSB guidance on appropriate formats	The following formats are permitted: • Adults – singles matches only	Not permitted in snooker clubs

		Disabled people, supervised activity for U18s, and activity for education purposes Clubs should not run one-day knockout or group competitions League competitions involving team formats should not take place	
Travel	Permitted within Tiers 1 and 2 – follow the rules for that area while there. Avoid travel to Tier 3 areas	Permitted within Tiers 1 and 2 – if travelling to Tier 1, follow Tier 2 rules. Avoid travel to Tier 3 areas	Avoid travelling to other parts of the UK
