The table below offers an overview of the Covid-19 Local Restriction Tiers with regard to permitted snooker and billiards activity. This information is indicative only and should be followed in line with current [UK Government guidance](#) and [EPSB guidance](#).

<b>1:1 Coaching</b>	Permitted – follow EPSB guidance	Permitted – coach with one household/bubble only	Not permitted in snooker clubs  Permitted in private facilities that are not open to the public
<b>Competition (club tournaments, local league)</b>	Permitted – follow EPSB guidance on appropriate formats	The following formats are permitted: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Adults – singles matches only</li> </ul>	Not permitted in snooker clubs

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Disabled people, supervised activity for U18s, and activity for education purposes</li> </ul> <p>Clubs should not run one-day knockout or group competitions</p> <p>League competitions involving team formats should not take place</p>	
<b>Travel</b>	Permitted within Tiers 1 and 2 – follow the rules for that area while there. Avoid travel to Tier 3 areas	Permitted within Tiers 1 and 2 – if travelling to Tier 1, follow Tier 2 rules. Avoid travel to Tier 3 areas	Avoid travelling to other parts of the UK
